We also provide residents with housekeeping, gardening and maintenance assistance.














Aveo - Built Form and Mixed-Use Developments

- Open views and access into the site from Darley Road with a new public parkland.
- Creating ageing in place opportunities for the fast-ageing northern beaches community.

Preservation

- Heritage celebrate and reactivate the main cluster of historic buildings focusing on community uses.
- Expanding the southern bushland edge
- Significant setbacks from boundaries and edge conditions offering public benefit in land and uses returned to the community for public use.

- A Health and Wellness centre a publicly accessible health support network focusing on preventative and primary care for the community
- Destinational play and fitness spaces including rehabilitation and hydrotherapy.

Community Needs

- Health Hive delivering a range of potential services including medical centre, specialist suites, allied health, physical rehabilitation and mental health services
- Potential for short stay accommodation offering respite and recovery.
- Publicly available community centre

- Local consultant procurement
- Collaboration with existing local community groups and local stakeholders
- Connection to Country First Nations engagement

- Flank the community spine with seniors living and health and wellbeing activities to allow for a permanent population. Economic value generated to Manly and Northern Beaches as a result of redevelopment
- Construction investment & ongoing maintenance
- Jobs creation, both construction and ongoing local business opportunities



Aveo's Masterplan concept – Public realm

Extensive green space:

To wrap the precinct in a landscape - gardens, public parkland, retained and enhanced bushland or a network of public spaces and streets.

Historic connection:

Retain and reactivate the main cluster of historic buildings with a focus on community uses.

Open views:

Open views and access to the site from Darley Road with a new public parkland.

Expand bushland:

Expand the Southern bushland edge and program with a diversity of engaging spaces accessible to the public.

Public spaces:

Create a network of welcoming, accessible and connected public spaces throughout the site.


Significant setbacks from boundaries and edge conditions:



SEARs issued:

Project-specific Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements ("SEARs") for the Concept and Early Works SSDA issued

Due Diligence:

Five-month detailed Due Diligence investigations commence.

This will include site inspections, drilling and testing of ground conditions, fauna studies etc

Engagement and documentation:

Formal community & stakeholder engagement to inform the preparation of the Concept Masterplan

SSDA Submission:

Formal SSDA Masterplan to be lodged with the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (DPHI).
