Our Process

Our process – What we do

- Overview of RV legislation
- Background on Operator and the Village
- Documents
 - General explanation of documents
 - VCD Village Comparison Document
 - PCD Prospective Costs Document
 - Residence Contract (eg Lease)
 - Bylaws
 - Check the forms/documents you have received
 - Explain special terms (eg ingoing contribution, exit fee, COP)
 - Explain timing and process
 - Operator to provide VCD and PCD 21 days before you sign Residence Contract
 - COP periods





Our Process

- Look at each step:
 - Before what you must do and pay when you enter the village
 - entry condition report
 - the payments (eg ingoing contribution)
 - settlement process what to expect
 - what facilities/services are available (what do you need now/in future)
 - update your powers of attorneys and wills
 - explain process to your family
 - During what you must do and pay when you are in the village:
 - insurance
 - General Service Fees/MRF
 - bylaws
 - upkeep of the unit who is responsible

 - Exit Fee
 - Capital Gain and Loss sharing
 - Reinstatement/Renovation Costs
 - Resale Price
 - General Service Fee capping
